On April 4-5, 2019 the Ohio Association of Gerontology and Education (OAGE), in conjunction with Miami University, is hosting the 43rd Annual Ohio Professional and Student Conference on Aging. The conference theme is ***Faces of Aging: Growth and Opportunities*** and it will be held on Miami's campus in Oxford, Ohio.
